

## 2008 Author Formatting Guidelines NCCC-134 Electronic Proceedings

All papers will be published in electronic format at the conference website (<http://www.farmdoc.uiuc.edu/nccc134/paperarchive.html>) and placed on AgEcon Search (<http://agecon.lib.umn.edu/>). No hard copies of proceedings will be printed.

Follow the style guidelines of the *American Journal of Agricultural Economics* with the exceptions noted below.

1. Papers must be **single-spaced** with one-inch margins on top, left and right and bottom. Double space between paragraphs. Left-justify section headings.
2. A separate title page should be the first page (see the sample paper and title page at <http://www.farmdoc.uiuc.edu/nccc134/pdf/example-paper-format-isengildina-irwin-good.pdf>). The title page should have the article title centered in boldface. Below title should be the authors' names in boldface with a footnote indicating author affiliations, e-mail addresses, and any acknowledgements or other relevant information.
3. Below the authors names on the title page should be the following statements:

*Paper presented at the NCCC-134 Conference on Applied Commodity Price Analysis,  
Forecasting, and Market Risk Management  
St. Louis, Missouri, April 21-22, 2008*

*Copyright 2008 by [authors names]. All rights reserved. Readers may make verbatim  
copies of this document for non-commercial purposes by any means, provided that this  
copyright notice appears on all such copies.*
4. On the first page of the text (page after title page), place the article title in boldface centered then place a **Practitioner's Abstract** in italic font followed by **Keywords** and then the **Introduction**. The abstract should use nontechnical language and concentrate on the practical implications of the results. It should not exceed 300 words.
7. Use a 12-point CG Times font (Courier or Times Roman is an acceptable substitute).
8. For references, including the month of publication is optional, you do not have to abbreviate journal titles, you may include authors' complete names, and you may include the year in the text.
9. We do not require each table and figure to be on a separate page.
10. The use of bold for vectors and matrices and italics for variable names is optional.
11. Page numbers should be included on the manuscript.
