

Guidelines for Digital Publication of NCCC-134 Conference Proceedings

1. Presenters should get completed drafts of papers to their session moderators as soon as possible.
2. Moderators should provide conference presenters with a summary of the suggestions provided by conference participants plus any of their own editorial direction on the paper.
3. To the extent possible, authors should incorporate both the feedback provided by conference participants and the editorial guidance provided by moderators.
4. All final papers should be sent to Scott Irwin (sirwin@uiuc.edu) by **June 1, 2008** to be included in the digital proceedings.
 - Adobe.pdf file of the entire paper following the NCCC-134 Author Guidelines (see guidelines and sample at <http://www.farmdoc.uiuc.edu/nccc134/submissions.html>).
 - For consistency, name the file using the last names of each author followed by NCCC-134_2008 (e.g., Irwin_Garcia_Good_NCCC-134_2008.pdf).
 - **Please print a hardcopy of your Adobe.pdf version and review the formatting closely before submitting the final electronic version.**
5. All papers received by June 1, 2008 will be posted to the NCCC-134 web site (<http://www.farmdoc.uiuc.edu/nccc134/paperarchive.html>) and AgEcon Search (<http://agecon.lib.umn.edu/>).
 - All papers will have a formatted cover page added that indicates the manuscript as being part of the NCCC-134 Conference Proceedings.
6. An email announcement of the digital publication of the NCCC-134 Conference Proceedings will be circulated.
